Access Psych is capable of providing immediate, comprehensive CIS services that can mitigate risk and minimise impact while protecting the psychological health, safety and wellbeing of your workforce anywhere in Australia.

Access Psych CIS services.

- An immediate, prompt and thorough response and action plan
- Ongoing counselling for impacted staff
- Professional support for workers involved in a serious incident
- Individual or group support, as required
- Support and coaching for managers
- Staff resources

Our CIS services can be scheduled immediately via our 24/7 triage service and we will have a qualified psychologist or psychologists onsite within 48 business hours.

Access Psych CIS services include individual or group support, as required, and include any support and coaching for managers and frontline supervisors. We will provide resources for your staff to support them and help them care for others impacted by a critical incident.

Our attending psychologist(s) will provide a written report within 5 business days of service delivery, including feedback and insights from those who attended.
