

Child ADHD Assessment

Welcome

Thank you for your interest in booking a Child ADHD Assessment with Access Psych. This handout provides a brief overview of what to expect if you choose to proceed with an assessment. Our aim is to help you and your child feel informed, supported and comfortable throughout the assessment journey.



What does an assessment involve?

A Child ADHD assessment at Access Psych is a 4-step process:

- 1. Parent and Teacher Questionnaires**
You (the child's parent or carer) and your child's teacher will complete online questionnaires.
- 2. Assessment Appointment**
You and your child will attend a 120-minute assessment with a psychologist. For children aged 6-12 years, the assessment must be completed in-person (Sydney or Adelaide CBD Clinics only).
- 3. Report Writing**
After the appointment, your psychologist will prepare a diagnostic report.
- 4. Parent Feedback**
In the parent feedback session, your psychologist will explain the outcome and provide recommendations.

Fees & Rebates

An ADHD Assessment Package is **\$1,750.00**, inclusive of the comprehensive assessment session, feedback session and a formal written diagnostic report.

Medicare: Medicare rebates may apply for ADHD assessments when referred by a paediatrician or psychiatrist under specific MBS items (for clients under 25).

Employee Assistance Programs (EAP): Most EAP and compensation schemes generally do not cover the cost of psychological assessments, though exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis. If you are unsure, please consult your employer.
